large groups and for buses.

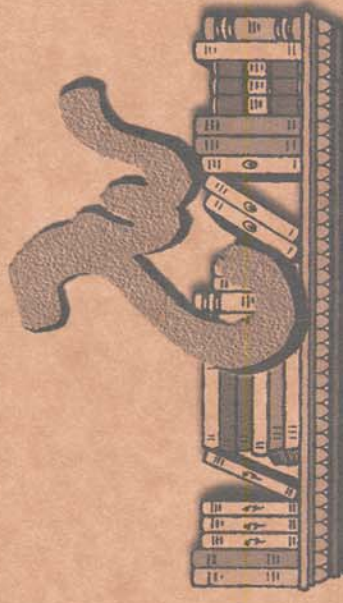
